#### **ATTENTION: 1st ENTRY DEADLINE ON NOVEMBER 1st!**

After we postponed our first cost-effective entry deadline (we reported on the reasons in our last newsletter) for our "Anniversary Coppa" by one month to **November 1st, 2025**, this date is now quickly approaching.

Take the opportunity and send us your entry before this date!

The 2nd entry deadline is **January 1st, 2026**, and the final entry deadline is **January 10th, 2026**.



### **REGISTRATION ISSUES**

### REGULATIONS

Gradually, explanations and sketches are being added to clarify the map reading systems to be driven. We recommend studying everything thoroughly.

### **CHANGES FROM THE COPPA 2026**

As we already announced and promised at our last Coppa, there are some changes regarding our time schedules.

Since our rally days were very long (starting every day early in the morning at 7:00 AM) and, due to the often difficult to find wanted hotels, the daily finishes were often only reached very late, we have, also due to the aging of many of our participants, as well as ourselves, made the daily sections a bit shorter. However, this does not mean that our usual quality will suffer.



For example, we will now start at 8:00 AM on all three rally days and arrive in the hotels a little earlier as usual.
