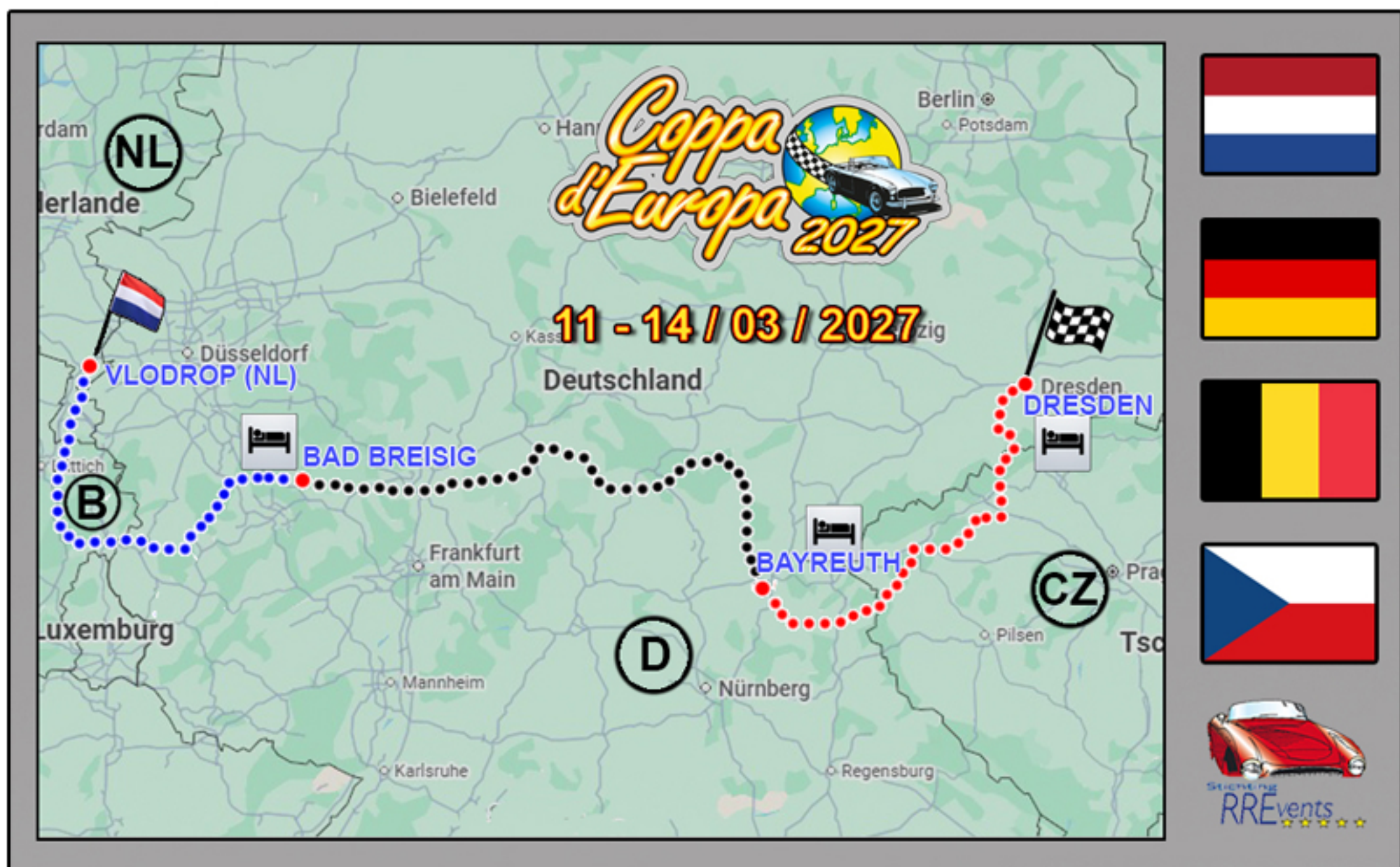




Foreword

Coppa d'Europa – Dates

The 21st Coppa d'Europa will take place from **11th March** to **14th March 2027**.

Coppa d'Europa – Route

In 2027, the Coppa d'Europa route will pass through four countries – the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany and the Czech Republic.
The starting point will be Vlodrop (NL), with the first overnight stay in Bad Breisig (D), the second in Bayreuth (D), and the third overnight stay and finish in Dresden (D).
